ENVIRONMENTAL ENDOWMENT FUND



By now every British Columbian has received a \$100.00 Green Rebate from the Provincial Government. This offers the opportunity for all citizens collectively to establish an environmental fund to effect positive changes in our Region in a community based manner thus leaving a lasting legacy to help keep our environment the way that it should be for all of us to enjoy. There will always be times when something needs to be done to ensure this. Having a fund available will help a great deal.

The Phoenix Foundation will be overseeing this fund. In order to establish this lasting legacy, \$5,000.00 is required for initial setup. Once we have hit this targeted amount it will officially become an endowment fund in perpetuity. Anyone who donates will be issued a charitable receipt. Interest from this fund will be disbursed on an annual basis and designated to environmental projects and educational initiatives. Approval of expenditures will be decided by the Christina Lake Stewardship Society under the direction of identified community need.

The environmental endowment fund will live on in perpetuity and the continuance of donations will ensure that we provide a legacy for the Christina Lake Watershed and surrounding areas within the Boundary Region. Since we can not access Columbia Trust Fund dollars for work that needs to be done here why not start up our own and have more control over our watershed and help other areas that require assistance such as the Kettle River for one example.

How can you become part of this lasting legacy?

- Donations can be delivered to the Reception Area of the Grand Forks District Savings Credit Union and the Phoenix Foundation will provide a charitable receipt. Cheque to be made payable to the Christina Lake Stewardship Society Environmental Endowment Fund.
- Donations can be dropped off at the Christina Lake Stewardship Society Office on 90 Park Road or mailed to PO Box 373, Christina Lake, BC V0H 1E0. A charitable receipt will be issued by the Society. Cheque to be made payable to the Christina Lake Stewardship Society with a notation that the funds are to be deposited into the Environmental Endowment Fund.
